

CT-2 "BUNKIE" CHANGING CABINET ASSEMBLY

Attention Please

- Carefully check shipment as received from the truck line for possible damage. Please report any damage immediately to a representative at Bunkie Cribs.
- Before beginning assembly, take inventory of parts listed below.
- Assembling on flattened shipping carton will protect the finish of unit.
- For ease of assembly, neatly arrange parts and follow directions step by step.

Inventory of Parts

- 2 Side Panels (18 1/2" x 34 1/2")
 - 2 Shelves (17" x 34 1/2") 1 Shelf (15 3/4" x 34 1/2")
 - 2 Top Rails (6 3/4" x 34")
 - 2 Bottom Rails (1 3/4" x 34")
 - 1 Back Panels (22 3/4" x 34 1/2")
 - 2 Doors (16 3/4" x 22")
 - 1 Hardware Pack (4 Sets of Door Hinges, 8 Screws, 12 Bolts, 1 Allen Wrench, 1 Safety Strap)
- Note: Assembled cabinet dimensions are approximately 35" high, 18 1/2" deep, and 35 1/2" wide

Assembly Steps

1. Take one side panel; using the pre-drilled holes, fasten it to 1 top rail and 1 bottom rail using Allen screws/wrench, fasten the other side panel to the rails, forming a "U" shaped unit. Using Allen wrench to tighten bolts.
2. Slide one of the hardboard shelves into the lower pre-cut grooves. Take another shelf with safety Strap cutout and slide into upper set of grooves.
3. Slide center shelf in place as above, and the white back panel. (in grooves)
4. Carefully put the other side panel in place and fasten the six bolts with Allen wrench.
5. Mount the door hardware onto the doors and cabinet using 16 screws.
6. Place the doors square on the unit, tightening after placement.
7. Place the safety strap through the top shelf and vinyl pad on top.

You have now completed the assembly of your beautiful oak changing cabinet. Remember to tighten all screws and remove all labels. To clean, wipe with damp cloth and do not use harsh detergents. As with any fine furniture, an occasional use of a high-quality, non-toxic polish will help keep your cabinet looking like new.

Warnings

Please carefully read all instructions before assembling cabinet. Failure to adhere to the following warnings could result in serious injury or death. Most importantly, **NEVER LEAVE A CHILD UNATTENDED**. We also recommend keeping these instructions in a handy place for possible future use.

- Before each usage or assembly, inspect table for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts, or sharp edges. **DO NOT** use cabinet if any parts are missing or broken. Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- When the child is able to climb off or reaches a height of 35" (90 cm), the cabinet should no longer be used.
- **DO NOT** place the cabinet near a window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle the child.
- If refinishing cabinet, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- **DO NOT LEAVE A CHILD UNATTENDED**. Be sure safety strap is in position whenever a child is on the changing table.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film for changing pad covers due to possible suffocation.
- **DO NOT** use a water mattress with this changing cabinet.
